

## Sunscreen Authorization Form

In order to comply with Department of Health Public Health Laws, campers can bring topical sunscreen to camp if: 1) the sunscreen is used for the purpose of avoiding overexposure to the sun and not for medical treatment of an illness of injury, 2) the sunscreen is approved by the FDA for over the counter use, and 3) the camper's parent or guardian provides written permission (this form) for the camper to carry and use the sunscreen -- a camper who is unable to physically apply sunscreen may be assisted by an Oasis staff member if permitted by a parent or guardian, and authorized by the camp.

## **Sunscreen Policy:**

- Each camper must have a signed Sunscreen Authorization Form on file before camper is allowed to use any sunscreen product.
- Sunscreen must be in its original packaging and labeled with the camper's name.
- Parent(s) are responsible for applying sunscreen to their children prior to their arrival to camp.
- Campers will keep their marked sunscreen in their backpacks at all times.
- Staff will remind the children to reapply their sunscreen throughout the day, especially after swim time. Campers will reapply the sunscreen themselves, but staff can assist ESIC if they request assistance. Please make sure to discuss with your camper how they should apply sunscreen.
- Any sunscreen products left on the camp premises after the camp session will be disposed of by the camp director.

## PARENT AUTHORIZATION:

By signing below, I understand all the OASIS Camps Sunscreen Policies as stated above. Before the Oasis Camp staff allows your child to apply sunscreen, you are required to sign this authorization form indicating your desire to have the sunscreen administered, as well as your agreement to relieve Camp Oasis, its agents, employees, or representative of any responsibility for ill effects resulting from the administering of said sunscreen as set forth within.
